Additional notes from the Annual Meeting:

- A special thank you went out to all those involved in the counting of the voting ballots, helping out at the annual meeting, mowing of the common areas and developer properties and to everyone who volunteers in the community.
- -A decision was made to repair broken glass in the door of the rec-room for \$576 by Roseburg Glass.
- -The pool is officially open and on 6-1-24 the spa will be open but the heater will be shut off for the summer.
- -There has been a member of the community who had not been paying their HOA dues. The issue has been resolved through the assistance of our lawyer.
- -The other voting results of the proposals are as follows:
- > Approval of the road repair of the community entrance by Dirty Duck Construction for \$28,826.00 and approval of crack seal for the rest of the roads (designated in the ballots) \$13,240 by the Stripping Company.
- > Raising of the dues to \$150 did not get approved. Since a quorum was present, it was put to a vote to raise the dues to \$125. That also did not get approval. As you will notice in the


